Presenter Bios

Joe Chaisson, Technical and Research Director

Joe brings nearly 30 years of experience in public policy analysis to his work at the Task Force. At the Task Force, Joe oversees dozens of technical analyses and studies each year, including work from CATF staff, major research universities, and consulting firms. He presents CATF's technical work in a variety of settings, including testimony before the US Congress, briefings of state and federal agencies and legislators, and industry conferences. Prior to his work at the Task Force, Joe worked with numerous regional and state environmental groups throughout the Northeast on advocacy related to air quality, water quality and land use policy; for 10 years, he worked with as Technical Director of the Conservation Law Foundation's Energy Project. He holds a B.A. from Harvard University.

Alex Farrell, Director, Center for Sustainable Transportation (UC Berkeley)

Alex's primary research interest is in improving our understanding of the environmental and social aspects of energy systems, and in the development of energy systems that support the world we desire to live in. He is particularly interested in better characterizing environmental impacts of energy production and transformation, especially air pollution and greenhouse gases, and in the economic, political, and other social aspects of energy systems with reduced environmental impacts. He is currently an Associate Professor at the Energy and Resources Group at UC Berkeley, and directs their Transportation Sustainability Research Center. Previously, he has taught at Carnegie Mellon and Harvard University. He holds a Ph.D. in Energy Management and Policy from UPenn.
